Out of Zone Report



SUMMARY

The Clark County School District (District) assigns each student residing in the district to a school that will offer the appropriate educational placement for that student. For various reasons, a parent or guardian may request that a student attend a school other than his or her assigned school.

The reasons a student may be approved by the superintendent or the superintendent's designee to attend a school outside the attendance zone in which the student resides may include Board-Approved Zoning Options, Magnet Programs, Open Enrollment, Special Education Program Placement and Zone Variances.

This report incorporates the following information: (1) the total number of zone variances approved; (2) the total number of Board-approved zone options, magnet school and program requests, Prime 6 and minority-to-majority requests granted; and (3) the impact of all exceptions approved on the capacity and racial and ethnic diversity of each school. This information for Validation Day, October 1, 2019, is formatted alphabetically by school type (elementary, middle, high school and special/alternative schools).
