

2020-2021 Elementary Capacity Study



SUMMARY

The Elementary Capacity Study provides information on the Program Capacity of each Elementary school. Program Capacity is updated annually to reflect the optimum use of each school building and to capture the changes to educational specifications and assigned specialized programs.

Standardized calculations are applied to each school using adopted student/teacher ratings. Rooms assigned for special use such as libraries and multi-purpose rooms are not assigned capacities.

The study lists the permanent rooms, student/teacher ratings, and 9 month capacity by Elementary school.

ELEMENTARY CAPACITY STUDY

Program capacity reflects optimum use of the building and captures the annual changes to educational specifications and assigned specialized programs. It is not design capacity or building utilization. To obtain consistency in establishing the program capacity for each elementary school, the following procedures are used for calculation:

1. Rooms that are designed for special use, such as teacher offices or workrooms, are not computed in the capacities, as they are not intended for instructional use.
2. Libraries and multi-purpose rooms are not assigned capacities.
3. The following pupil/teacher ratings are used:

After all support and specialized programs are assigned permanent rooms, the remaining rooms are assigned to kindergarten through 5th grade. The number of rooms assigned to each grade level is determined by applying the pupil/teacher ratings to allow sufficient seats for the roll up of students at each grade level.

Some schools were built with class size reduction rooms and others were built with divisible 1st and 2nd grade classrooms. New schools built with 53 rooms have additional support rooms (Flex and STEM). Portable classrooms are not calculated into the program capacity.
